- Give each document a clear name, in English, such as "Business registration document Company Name".

If you are submitting a full list of entities in a spreadsheet or email, then please clearly indicate which ones are new.

*Articles of Incorporation or similar

May be called Memoranda of Incorporation, Bylaws, Deeds of Partnership. It is a legal document that outlines the rules and regulations of a company or organization. It contains the names of all the subscribers, i.e. the people who were there at the founding point of the company, and the Articles of Association, which are a set of rules that govern how the company is run.

If Applicable:

Point 11	Any national or state licenses to export or import precious stones or precious metals.	
Point 12	Any national or state licenses to mine or trade precious stones or precious metals.	



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
